Some of the items from the wide range of tools and accessories are:

- Cobrahead described as a giant fingernail, it cultivates, mixes compost and churns through the soil
- Spork a spade/fork which promotes less adhesion, less surface area and aeration of soil
- Transplanter trowel good for nutgrass removal as well as transplanting bulbs
- **Plant cloche** to nurture seedlings, deter pests, for frost protection or to hang as a light shade!
