Special Thanks go to the Events Committee, Plant Stalls, and Produce Stall Coordinators, and the Finance Team and Ticket Stall volunteers who managed the money. Inviting Rotary to manage the parking proved to be very effective as it streamlined the movement and parking of vehicles on the day. We will invite Rotary to join us again this year. The MGC donated \$500 to Rotary as a Thank You for supporting the event.

Financially the event was a great success, resulting in a profit of \$10,301.00 This enabled the club to donate equipment such as Chainsaws and accompanying Batteries to the value of \$2,000 to the RFS and \$2,000 to the SES. A further \$3,000 has been placed in a Term Deposit for the Maleny Hospital Auxiliary to be used to purchase equipment for the Palliative Care Rooms at the Maleny Soldiers Memorial Hospital once the renovations have been completed. The balance of the monies was used to purchase 3 Laptops, one for each Office Bearer so that all MGC Documentation can be stored, viewed and archived in the one central location. At the same time the Email addresses for the club were reviewed of which there are 6. These being:

President, Secretary, Treasurer, Web Admin, Trips and Speakers

Working Bees have been undertaken at the Camellia Walk on Settlers Green, Pattemore House and in the Maleny Hospital Grounds. An Activity Sheet will be circulated at the next meeting to encourage members to become more involved as working bees are required.

The Digital History of the Maleny Garden Club on the MGC Website was established in October 2022 when the Club celebrated it's 70th Birthday. Chris Skrzecynski continues to manage the MGC digital history and is constantly updating the information. Our thanks go to Chris for her dedication to this ongoing project.
